#### 1. Convene, Roll Call and Introduction of Audience

The meeting was convened at 1:09 pm. Roll call was taken, a quorum noted. Audience introductions were made.

## 5. <u>Public Comment/Correspondence</u>

a. J. Ezzell – Education Qualifications

Mr. Ezzell addresses the board regarding his qualifications and education in reference to his civil engineering application. He states that he provided 2 additional references and a letter to further assist the board with their decision.

Mr. Skarsgard addresses Mr. Folk as well as Mr. Ezzell in regards to 16.39.3-13 (c) education requirements, to explain how they feel that Mr. Ezzell's education complies with the education portion in the NM Engineering and Surveying Practice Act. Mr. Ezell states that he feels his geology degree would work for a related science degree. He states that other states he requested licensure in had also asked for additional information because of his geology degree. He would like to have noted that his main focus in work in soil testing, that if approved he would not practice outside of any discipline that he does not feel educated in. Mr. Folk addresses the board that this interpretation follows the NCEES model rule for licensing across the country. Geotechnical and material testing fall under Civil, since NM does not recognize them as a separate discipline. NCEES model rule considers a related science degree in chemistry, science, mathematics or any other related curriculum. What NCEES did to assure that the applicants would be qualified is require addition work experience to take the exam and test. Mr. Tonander asks Mr. Folk, who serves on the Arizona board as a public member, if Mr. Ezzell was brought before his board his thoughts on if they would approve his application. Mr. Folk's response is yes. Mr. Skarsgard asks Mr. Ezzell and Mr. Folk to provide more research, specifically in reference to NMSA 61.23.14.21.D 1 "the standards required by the licensure or the applicant's qualifications equaled or exceeded the licensure standards in NM at the time the applicant was initially licensed"

Mr. Skarsgard asks for a side by side review of the 4 states that the applicant is licensed in (NC, CO, VA, MD) analyze if any one of those 4 states qualifications were equivalent or exceeded NM standards at the time of licensure. Mr. Skarsgard also asks for an elaborated analysis to be compared to ABET's general criteria standards, outlined in Section 5 on the ABET website.

#### b. T. Ficken – Education Qualifications

Mr. Ficken addresses the board and states that he has been an engineer since 1985, recognized by Colorado since 2005, and is a principle of an A&E firm. Mr. Ficken read an extract stating that 'The physics degree was designed as fundamentals of engineering', Mr. Ficken feels very confident in understanding the basics of engineering. He would like to note that he would only practice engineering in the fields in which he feels he has expertise. He feels that his educational and work background is sufficient for approval as an engineer with disciplines in structural as well as civil engineering.

Mr. Tonander thanked the corresponding applicants and counsel for the additional information to aid them in their decision.
